110 job seekers participated in the NESF SAIF 7th Annual Career Fair

29 Employers came out to provide job opportunities to the community

17 (and counting) gained employment as a result of having attended the career fair.

Supportive Assistance for Individuals and Families (SAIF) Program: The overall goal of this Initiative is to provide intensive case management to assist the targeted population in moving from dependency on cash assistance to being self-supporting within 24 months.



This year, the Newark Emergency Services for Families, Supportive Assistance for Individuals and Families program had a vision for our 7th Annual Career Resource Fair. The vision was to increase the number of employers in an attempt to address all fields of employment and training and to open it to the Public! What an extravaganza! This year, we had an array of employers and training resources.
